### **GROUND BREAKING SET FOR UNIQUE BURGER KING**

**TEMPLE TERRACE, FL. – (10/7/13)** – You’ll soon be able to “have it your way” at one of the most unusual Burger King restaurants in America.

A ground-breaking ceremony is scheduled for 10 a.m. on Wednesday, Oct. 9, 2013 at the site of a planned Burger King restaurant at 8755 N. 56<sup>th</sup> St. in Temple Terrace. But, this is no ordinary Burger King.

Quality Dining, Inc., the restaurant’s owner, went the extra mile to make the building compatible with the Mediterranean-Revival motif of Temple Terrace’s downtown redevelopment area (the southeast corner of 56<sup>th</sup> Street and Bullard Parkway).

The 3,104-sq.-ft. building’s architectural design will include trellis window canopies, Spanish-style parapets, a cedar arbor, a decorative arched doorway, and other architectural flourishes. The site also will feature lush landscaping.

“It’s a unique building,” said Quality Dining Chairman and CEO Daniel Fitzpatrick. “We’ve never built [a Burger King] like this before.”

Mayor Frank Chillura, top officials from Quality Dining, and other guests and dignitaries will be on hand for the ceremonial ground-breaking event on Wednesday. Fitzpatrick said construction on the facility will begin immediately. Officials said construction should take about 60 days.
