POLICE DEPARTMENT AWARDED REACCREDITATION

TEMPLE TERRACE, FL. – (6/30/14) – The Temple Terrace Police Department has been awarded reaccreditation by the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation, Inc., commission officials announced.

More than 20 agencies were awarded accreditation or reaccreditation during the Florida Accreditation Conference last week in Bonita Springs. The Temple Terrace Police Department was approved for reaccreditation. The department was first awarded statewide Accredited Agency status in 2011.

Accreditation is difficult to achieve and confirms a law-enforcement agency meets stringent operational requirements. The Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation, Inc., based in Tallahassee, reviews all aspects of an agency's policies and procedures, management, operations and support services to determine compliance with nearly 300 recognized standards of excellence in law enforcement.

CFA directors voted unanimously in June 2011 to present the Temple Terrace Police Department with a Certificate of Accreditation. Accreditation is an important achievement because it assures a community that its police department performs at the highest level of professionalism, said Temple Terrace Police Chief Kenneth Albano.
