POLICE MAKE ARREST IN ARMED ROBBERY CASE

TEMPLE TERRACE, FL. – (2/23/15) – Police have arrested a 22-year-old man in connection with last week's armed robbery outside the U.S. Post Office in Temple Terrace.

Ronald N. Ball III (DOB 5/9/1992), no known address, was arrested Feb. 20 and charged with Armed Robbery with a Firearm, Armed Burglary, and Fraudulent Use of a Credit Card.

Temple Terrace police said they received a tip after someone saw news accounts of the crime and recognized the suspect. Ball was arrested Friday afternoon with the assistance of other area law enforcement agencies.

The robbery occurred Feb. 17 at approximately 9:10 a.m. in the 8700 block of N. 56th Street, Temple Terrace. A woman had exited her car in front of the U.S. Post Office and was approached by a man with a handgun demanding money.

The robber took the woman's purse, police said. After the robbery, the suspect used the victim's credit cards at several locations outside Temple Terrace. The victim was not injured.
