### **SUSPECTS ARRESTED IN ATTEMPTED BANK ROBBERY**

**TEMPLE TERRACE, FL. – (08/10/2015)** – With the assistance of the Lee County Sheriff's Office, Temple Terrace police have identified two suspects responsible for the attempted armed robbery of the Wells Fargo Bank, 9775 N. 56<sup>th</sup> St., on July 31, 2015.

The two men, both from Fort Myers, were arrested Monday and charged in the crime.

The Temple Terrace Police Department received a 9-1-1 call on July 31, 2015 at 10:06 a.m. reporting an attempted bank robbery at the bank. Two armed men entered the bank and unsuccessfully attempted to rob the bank before fleeing in a green 2004 Volkswagen Jetta.

The Jetta had been reported stolen from Lee County and was recovered a short time later at Florida College, 119 N. Glen Arven Ave., Temple Terrace. At the college, the suspects set the Jetta on fire and fled in a stolen silver 2004 Toyota Tundra.

An investigation led law enforcement to the two suspects. Both men were taken into custody Monday by the Lee County Sheriff's Office. They are being charged by the Temple Terrace Police Department with Attempted Armed Robbery, Arson, and Conspiracy.
