TEMPLE TERRACE, FL. – 11/4/15 – Temple Terrace City Hall and other government offices will be closed on Wednesday, Nov. 11, 2015 in recognition of *Veterans Day*.

Please join us for a special Veterans Day program Nov. 11 from 3 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Omar K. Lightfoot Recreation Center, 10901 N. 56th St., Temple Terrace. It is Temple Terrace's way of saying "thank you" to the men and women who have served in America's armed forces. All area veterans and their families are invited to attend.

This year's guest speaker is the Rev. Bernie Lieving, who joined the U.S. Army in 1967 and served as chaplain for 27 years. His assignments included two stints in Germany. He also served as a combat chaplain in Vietnam and served in Operation Desert Storm in Saudi Arabia.

This year's event is co-sponsored by the Greater Temple Terrace Chamber of Commerce. Mayor Frank Chillura will welcome guests and offer opening remarks. The King High Naval Junior ROTC will present the colors.
