CITY OF TEMPLE TERRACE ELECTION RESULTS

TEMPLE TERRACE, FL. – (11/9/16) – Frank M. Chillura and Andrew “Andy” Ross were elected to the Temple Terrace City Council in Tuesday’s General Election. Mayoral candidate Kim D. Leinbach, who ran unopposed, will become the City’s new mayor.

Chillura and Ross will assume the seats currently held by Eddie Vance and Grant Rimbey, neither of whom ran for re-election. Chillura, the City’s current mayor, chose to run for City Council instead of seeking a second term as mayor.

Here are the unofficial election results as reported by the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections Office.
