## ARREST MADE IN CONNECTION WITH LOCAL DOCTOR'S DEATH

[Temple Terrace, Florida 7-2-2018] – Igbinosa Oghubor, 35, of Tampa, has been arrested in connection with the fatal vehicle crash that killed a local doctor earlier this year.

On March 28, Dr. Charles Williams, Jr., 70, of Temple Terrace, was killed when the vehicle he was driving was struck by another vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed.

The Temple Terrace Police investigation revealed that immediately prior to impact Williams was stopped on Gillette Avenue for the red traffic signal at the intersection of Fowler Avenue. When the signal turned green, Williams proceeded north into the intersection and was immediately struck on the driver's side by Oghubor's vehicle.

Oghubor was driving a 2014 Dodge Charger eastbound on Fowler Avenue in the center lane. The Police Department's reconstruction of the crash calculated Oghubor's speed to be at least 95 miles per hour. The Dodge's vehicle data recorder revealed that Oghubor's speed five seconds before impact ranged from 87 to 93 miles per hour.

Using this information, the Police Department obtained an arrest warrant charging Oghubor with vehicular manslaughter. Oghubor was taken into custody Sunday evening, 7-1-2018, at the Orlando International Airport as he returned to the United States from a trip abroad.

Oghubor is currently being held in the Orange County jail on \$75,000 bond.
