The City of Temple Terrace Fire Department continues to assist with the recovery efforts in the aftermath of Hurricane Florence. We welcomed home Training Officer Joe Cable and Fire Inspector Casey Hannah from the affected area this week as they were relieved by Engineer David Cruz and Firefighter Andrew Renner. The two are now in Goldsboro, NC transporting patients to and from shelters and hospitals, as well as assisting with patient care with Pasco County and Hillsborough County Fire Rescues.



### CONTRACTOR FINISHING ROADWAY PAVEMENT WORK IN TWO NEIGHBORHOODS

The next time you drive out near the 52<sup>nd</sup>/53<sup>rd</sup>/Serena/Whiteway neighborhood or the West River Area neighborhood, check out the new road surfaces. The City's contractor is finishing up repaving work this week. Part of the Pavement Management Plan, City Council approved the contract work on July 17 for \$586,022.50. Uncle Sam also contributed \$136,022.50 toward this project through the Federal Government's Community Development Block Grant. Congrats to the Public Works on getting things done in this "Amazing City!" (Thanks to City Engineer Vinny Corazza for the update.)

## NEIGHBORHOOD SWEEPS

The Temple Terrace Code Compliance Department continues to seek opportunities to be responsive to residents and improve the quality of life in our community. As part of this effort, the department conducts annual “neighborhood sweeps,” temporarily shifting code enforcement officers from their assigned zones to focus on specific areas of the city.

The Central northeast neighborhoods (Zone 3) including the communities bounded by E. Fowler Avenue to the north, E. Fletcher Avenue to the south, Hollow Stump Road to the east and Morris Bridge Road to the west have been selected for inspection, beginning Thursday, September 27, 2018 and continuing through the end of the week. These inspections will take place between 8am and 5pm.
