CRIME PREVENTION TIP:

Hit and run accidents are an unfortunate occurrence which sometimes can leave you stranded and confused. Someone may be injured or your car maybe totaled, and you're just trying to get a grip on the fact that the person who may have caused the accident just ran off. So here are a few tips on what to do if you find yourself the victim of a hit and run. First of all call for help, you may have a legal obligation to remain at the scene of the accident. Do not chase the other vehicle as you may cause further damage to yourself or others. If you can, identify the make, model, and color of the other car. If you can see the license plate number, write it down. A description of the driver will be helpful as well. If you can identify any witnesses, make sure you collect contact information; it will assist the officer and your insurance company. Make sure you call your insurance company. Call an attorney if your insurance company is being difficult or the police found the fleeing party. With these tips you have the knowledge you need to react to a Hit and Run situation.
