## BOARD VACANCY: POLICE OFFICERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM PENSION BOARD

The Mayor and City Council are accepting applications from citizens interested in being considered for appointment to the Police Officers Retirement System Pension Board of Trustees. The Board meets the second Thursdays of February, May, August and November at 8am in the City Manager's Conference Room at City Hall. The fifth Trustee of this Board does not have to be a resident of the City, serves without remuneration, and is appointed for two years. The closing date for receiving applications is 5pm on July 25. Equal consideration will be given to persons submitting applications and persons recommended by members of the City Council.
