



NEW AND IMPROVED CITY WEBSITE

Sometime today, the City's website will have a whole new look (Pictured is a sneak peek). Marketing and Communications Officer Laurie Hayes (with help from Beth Mayberry, Greg Pauley, and, most recently, Intern Nathan Bynum) has been working with CivicPlus for more than six months to plan the transition. The changes being facilitated by Civic Plus are largely cosmetic, so while the site will look and feel fresh and new, the functionality should remain the same. In addition, some inside pages have been added or updated and City staff from all departments have been working hard to replace PDFs with fillable forms built into the site both for a better customer experience overall and to comply with ADA rules.
