## City of Temple Terrace News

Following a suspension of collection due to cautions surrounding COVID-19, the City will resume its complimentary recycling program for residents in the following manner.

Paper and cardboard collection of recyclable paper products has already begun. Residents should put paper products only in their green bins and place curbside on their regular recycling pick-up day. Bins containing materials other than paper products will not be serviced.

Metals and plastics will be collected. Beginning today, July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020, the City will provide strategically placed receptacles around the City in which residents may deposit metals and plastic goods to be collected for recycling.

Neighborhood Recycling Drop-Off Locations:

- Scout Park Parking Lot
- 113th St. Parking Lot (near Greco Middle School)
- Family Recreation Complex Parking Lot
- Omar K. Lightfoot Center Parking Lot
- 78th St. Right-of-Way (near Lift Station)

The City is discontinuing separated glass recycling. Residents should place glass items into their regular garbage, which is taken to a Waste-to-Energy plant for incineration.
