Central northeast neighborhoods (Zone 3) including the communities bounded by E. Fowler Avenue to the north, E. Fletcher Avenue to the south, Hollow Stump Road to the east and Morris Bridge Road to the west.

NOTICE OF INSPECTIONS

The Temple Terrace Code Compliance Department continues to seek opportunities to be responsive to residents and improve the quality of life in our community. As part of this effort, the department conducts annual “neighborhood sweeps,” temporarily shifting code enforcement officers from their assigned zones to focus on specific areas of the city.

Your neighborhood has been selected for inspection, beginning **Thursday, September 24, 2020** and continuing through the end of the week. These inspections will take place between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Code enforcement officers will be in your neighborhood, verifying that dwellings, accessory structures, yards and vehicles are consistent with City Code standards. Officers will not walk onto your property to inspect it. If a violation is observed from the right-of-way, a courtesy notice will be left at your residence identifying the item(s) of concern.

In 2013, the Temple Terrace City Council revised code ordinances to raise the bar on community standards. The shift from minimum to moderate standards was adopted to enhance the appearance of our neighborhoods and preserve property values.
