Requirements for Operating Golf Carts on City Streets

In response to growing interest in golf carts, the City of Temple Terrace has approved their use on city streets. Golf carts are increasingly used to make short trips for shopping, social and recreation from nearby residential neighborhoods. By enacting laws governing the use of golf carts, the city is encouraging the use of passenger-friendly vehicles that allow for safe, low speed transportation that offer a variety of advantages including low cost, energy efficient mobility. While encouraging their use, the city requests that adopted regulations be obeyed for everyone's safety and enjoyment.



New Provisions

Golf cart owners wishing to use carts on city streets must register with the City of Temple Terrace. A separate registration is required with Temple Terrace Golf & Country Club to allow personal carts on their golf course. Drivers must possess a valid driver's license and obey all rules of the road. Carts are prohibited from using or crossing any state or county right(s)-of-way, i.e. Fowler, Fletcher, 56th, Busch, Bullard, Temple Terrace Highway. Carts are allowed to cross Bullard Parkway using golf cart tunnels and the intersection of Glen Arven Avenue and Bullard Parkway.



Minimum Equipment

- Brake system
- Reliable steering
- Horn
- Safe tires
- Rearview mirror
- Manufacturers serial number plate
- Red reflective warning devices, min. 4" square/round, both in front and rear

Additional equipment needed for operation after sunset.

Registering Your Cart

Registration is easy and begins December 1 for the coming year. Applicants may obtain a registration form online at TempleTerrace.com (under the Resident Help Center menu) and bring it to Customer Service, first floor of city hall.

With a \$10 registration fee and completed form, Customer Service will provide an annual decal to be placed on the cart driver's side front panel. For a complete review of regulations, see city code chapter 20, article III on our website.
