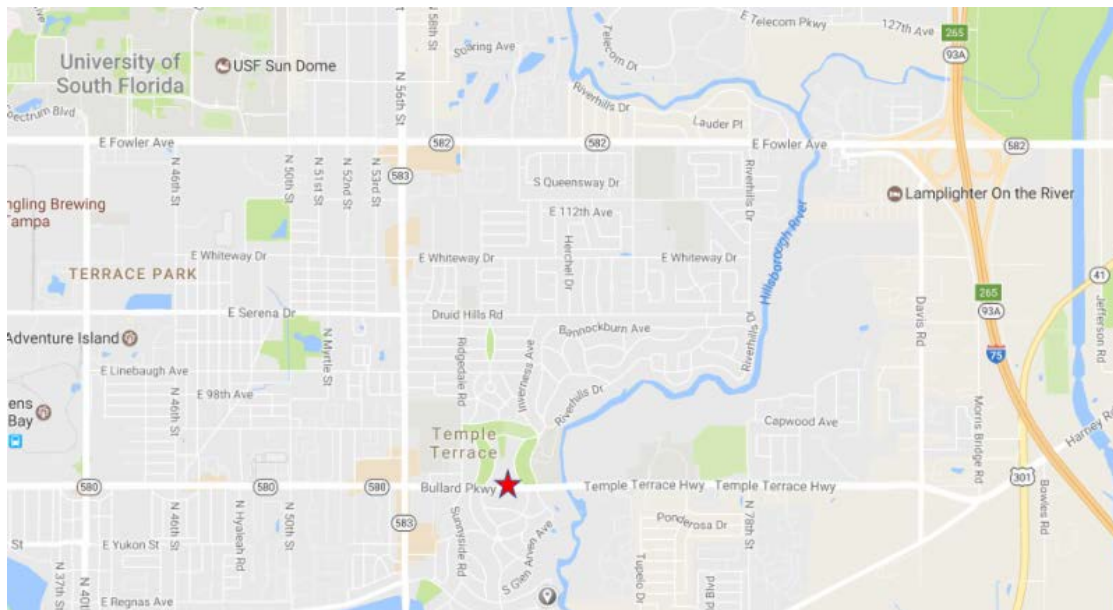


Please join us in reducing our traffic deaths to zero!

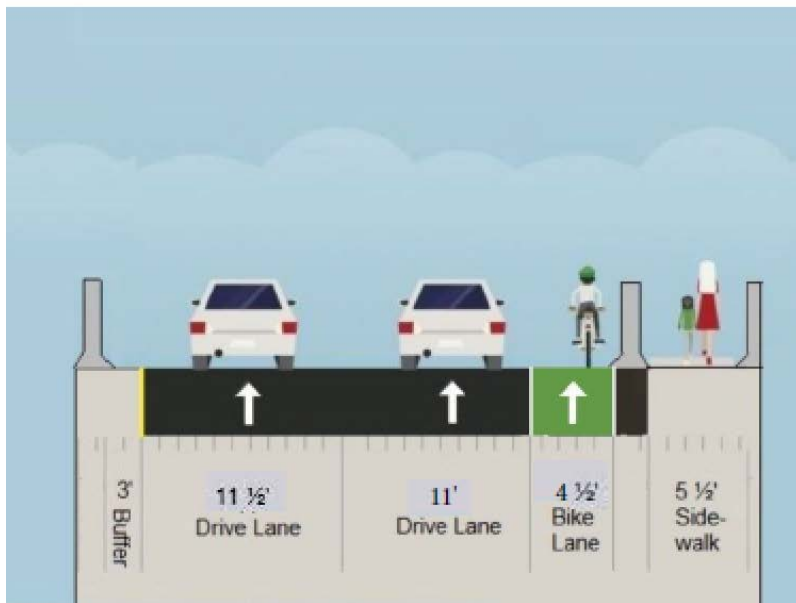
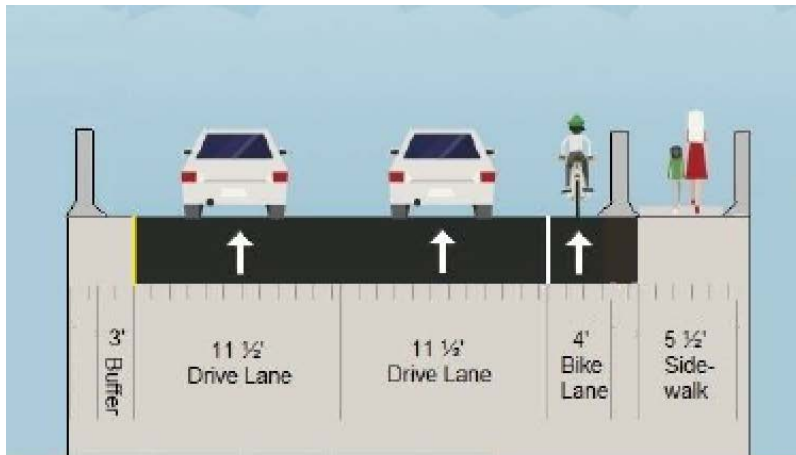
