TWO REGULAR MEMBER APPOINTMENTS AVAILABLE FOR THE
TEMPLE TERRACE RIVER WATCH TASK FORCE

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Temple Terrace are accepting applications from citizens interested in being considered for appointment as regular members on the Temple Terrace River Watch Task Force.

The Temple Terrace River Watch Task Force was established to better understand and ensure representation in decisions affecting the Hillsborough River. The Task Force's goal is to "preserve, protect, and enhance the Hillsborough River watershed, especially as it impacts the River's water quality and quantity in Temple Terrace."

The River Watch Task Force meets on the third Monday of each month, at 4:30 p.m., in the Council Conference Room at City Hall, 11250 N. 56th Street. Additional meetings may be scheduled as deemed necessary by the committee. This is a five-member committee appointed by the Mayor and City Council to serve three-year terms for up to three consecutive terms. Members must be residents of the City and serve without remuneration. Financial disclosure is not required.

Persons interested in serving as a regular member on the Temple Terrace River Watch Task Force can either download a Citizen Board Handbook and application from the City's website at www.templeterrace.com or contact the City Clerk's office at 506-6440. All applications should be returned to the Deputy City Clerk, 11250 N. 56th Street, Temple Terrace, Florida, 33617. Equal consideration will be given to persons submitting applications and persons recommended by members of the City Council.
