LIVABLE ROADWAYS COMMITTEE

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Temple Terrace are accepting applications from citizens interested in serving as the City's representative on the Livable Roadways Committee. The LRC is a 22-member body that reviews and strives to create a transportation system that balances design and aesthetics with issues of roadway safety and function. It reviews transportation and roadway plans and policies, making recommendations for improvement. The committee discusses topics related to transit, pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure and roadway design, safety and function. Focused on streetscape beautification, site and building design, landscape, environmental protection, preservation and signage, the committee is committed to considering all modes of transportation in the recommendations it makes. The LRC members include representatives from Hillsborough County, each of the three municipalities, FDOT District 7, the University of South Florida, the Planning Commission, and six additional members at large. All members are appointed by the Board of County Commissioners from a list of nominees approved by the LRC.

The LRC holds its regular meetings on the fourth Wednesday of each month at 9:00 a.m. in the offices of the Hillsborough County City-County Planning Commission, 601 E. Kennedy Blvd., Tampa, Florida. Temple Terrace's representative **MUST** be a resident of the City of Temple Terrace. Members of this Advisory Committee serve without remuneration and financial disclosure is not required.
