CRIME PREVENTION TIP:

Online shopping is more popular than ever. With all of the convenience and speed that comes with it, also comes risk of your identity or financial information being stolen. So here are a few tips on how to protect yourself while shopping online this season. First of all make sure you're on the correct website and look for a padlock shaped symbol in the left side of the URL bar, this indicates that a website is secure for you to make purchases on. When making purchases online we suggest you use a credit card if you can. The reason being is that credit card come with more protection from fraud, you are able to resolve fraudulent purchases faster than with using your debit card which could take weeks to resolve. Also see if your credit institution offers additional protection services you may want to take advantage of. As we said last week for shopping out and about, if you do see a fraudulent charge on your statement call your creditor immediately and freeze the card. Don't do your online shopping while connected to public Wi-fi, criminals can access the information passed through these networks. With these online shopping can be convenient and safe!
