CRIME INCIDENT INFORMATION:

Between the dates of 6/21/2019 and 6/27/2019, auto burglaries, the most common crime in Temple Terrace, were **down 50%** from the same period in 2018. Incidents among burglaries, robberies, and vehicle thefts are **down 40%** from the same period in 2018. Monday, the 24th of June, had the most incidents and commonly occurred between 8pm and 9pm. This data is representative of burglaries, robberies and vehicle thefts in the jurisdiction of the City of Temple Terrace.

CRIME PREVENTION TIP:

The correct car seat safety for your child is a crucial part of safe summer road trips. Here are a few things you can do as a parent to help ensure your child's safety. The first step to ensure safety is buying the right car seat. Your baby needs to ride in a rear-facing car seat as long as possible, at least until age 2. When your child has outgrown that seat, you are ready for a [forward-facing car seat](#). The next step is installing your car seat. You'll need to decide on using either the seat belt or lower anchors to secure your car seat. Both are safe, but don't use them both at the same time. Once your child is forward facing, it is important to use the tether with the seat belt or lower anchors. Safe kids worldwide provides [car seat checkup events](#). If you're not sure how to install a car seat, [instructions](#) available on the internet. A properly-fitted 5-point harness gives the best possible protection for your child. A 5-point harness has straps that go over both shoulders and both hips and then buckles at the crotch. It will tell you the weight and height range of the harness. Check regularly to make sure your child hasn't outgrown it. Once your child outgrows the 5-point harness, the adult seat belt is used with the belt positioning booster seat. Learn about the right fit for [babies](#), [little kids](#) and [big kids](#). Pay attention for when to change your car seat. Look on the car seat label to make sure your child is still within the weight, height and age limits for that seat. Get details about when to change your car seat.
