Need to register your golf cart with the City? Maintain the cleanliness of the store; an unorganized store makes it easier to shoplift. Make sure you build relationships with customers and greet everyone that walks in. Greeting each customer tells them that you know they're in your store. Installing an entrance alert sensor can help recognize when someone walks in will help you remain aware. Employing convex mirrors in the corners of the store help you keep an eye on the store. Use shorter displays to be able to have clear vision throughout the store. All ways keep an eye on the register or always have an employee managing it. Try to position the register near the front of the store.
